Deep-seated prejudice, rigid hiring, and a lack of tailored support deny job opportunities to people with developmental disabilities. This causes repeated job failures and short tenures. Accumulated income loss, social isolation, and future anxiety then severely restrict their independence and relationship-building.

Developing customized jobs and training tailored to the traits and capabilities of individuals with developmental disabilities. We support stable employment retention through on-the-job training, job placement, and workplace adaptation assistance.

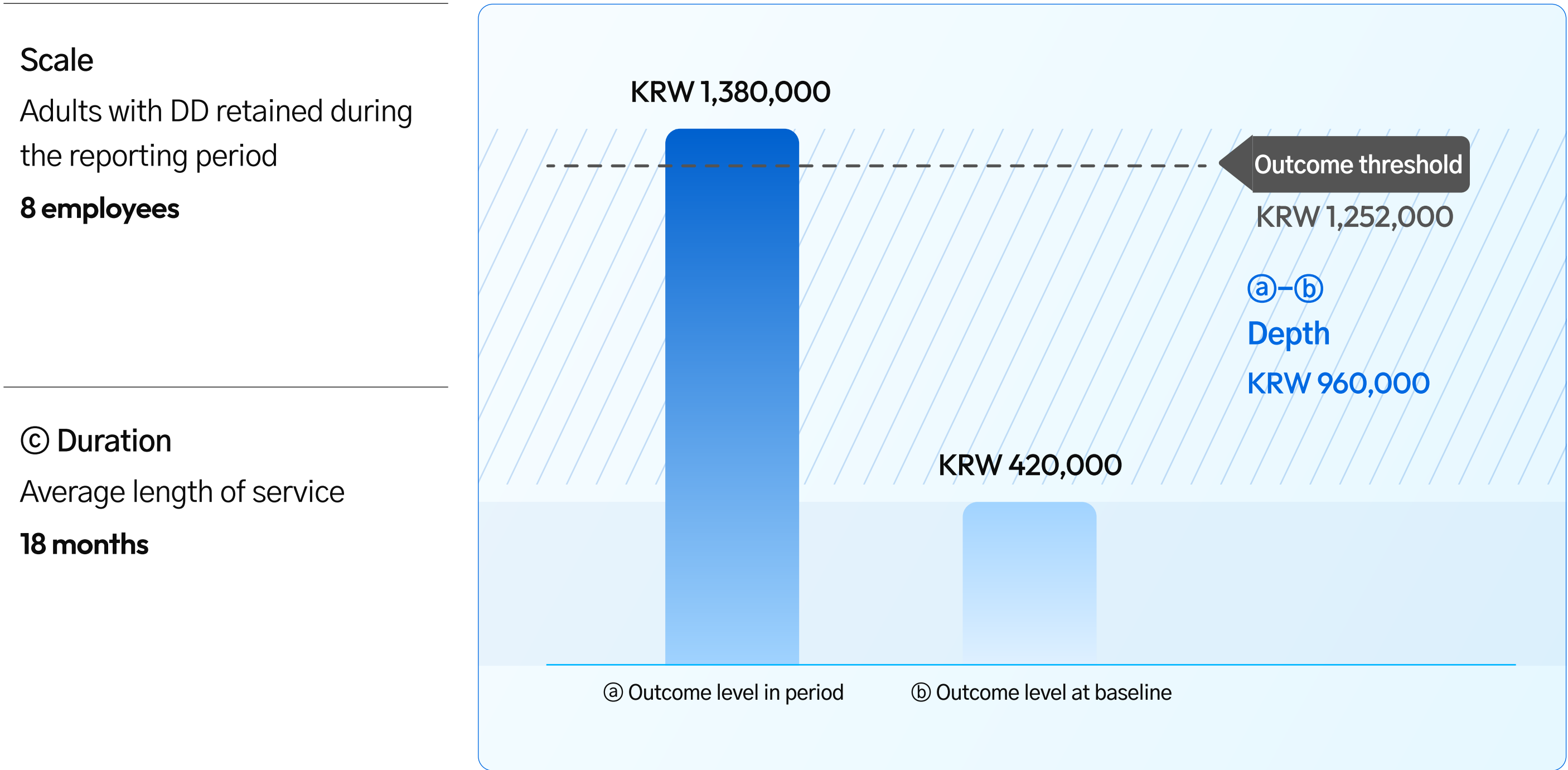

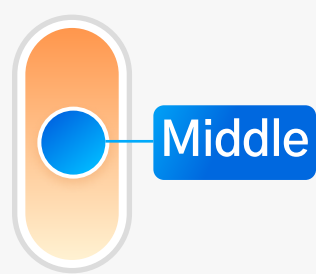

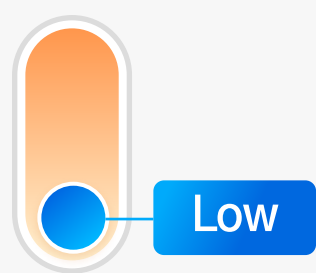

Current earned income is based on payroll records. Pre-hiring income is estimated via guardian interviews and may have minor errors.

Planned to hire 5 individuals with developmental disabilities, but 1 withdrew for personal reasons, resulting in 4 final hires.

⊛ Expected significant changes in outcomes in the next disclosure year

Next year, we plan to expand developmental disability hiring via partners and strengthen training and adaptation support to ensure stable employment and higher monthly income.

⊛ Impact performance assessment

During the reporting period, Daon Bridge Lab Co., Ltd. provided suitable jobs for 8 adults with developmental disabilities. Monthly income rose from KRW 420,000 to KRW 1,380,000 (+KRW 960,000 per capita). An average 18-month tenure helped lay a foundation for economic independence. Their current average income exceeds the 2025 statutory minimum wage adjusted for actual working hours.
